



More and more companies recognize sustainability as a core value and want to actively contribute to a future-proof world together with their teams.


WWF enables you to engage deeply with current sustainability topics through hands-on, interactive workshops.

Reducing Your Personal CO₂ Footprint - Discover Your Climate Impact



An individual impact

The impacts of climate change are being felt all around the globe, and the scale of the problem seems so overwhelming that we simply do not know where to begin.

The good news is that individual actions can and do make a big difference. WWF Switzerland offers an interactive workshop for employees who care about climate change and who want practical tips on maximizing their personal efforts to reduce emissions.

This workshop includes:

- **Learning:** about the science, background and urgency of our climate challenge
- **Analysing:** participants asses their present carbon footprint & define their own relevant reduction areas
- **Discussing:** exchange and sharing of ideas among the team
- **Individualising:** participants get their own questions answered

Take-aways:

- achievable micro steps that fit into the employee's personal lives
- pledge to maintain a long-lasting positive climate impact



A resource light society

The future is circular! Join our workshop that not only consists of several practical, entertaining mini-workshops on the topic of "Zero waste" but also offers participants suggestions and exercises on the topics of "circular economy" and "circular thinking".

This workshop includes:

- **Discussion:** Keeping resources in cycles - what does that mean? And what are the benefits?
- **Insights:** the potential of a low-waste lifestyle with short, entertaining do-it-yourself workshops, such as making a deodorant or cleaning spray
- **Exploring:** discover alternatives to conventional consumption and production and enjoy a visit to a local circular economy project

Take-aways:

- Practical food for thought on the topic of circular economy and waste reduction
- Homemade natural products (e.g. deodorant) and other inspiring instructions to take home

Duration: 3.5 hours

The Future of Food



How we eat sustainably and avoid food waste

Did you know that agriculture is responsible for 80% of global deforestation and 70% of the terrestrial biodiversity loss?

In our "The Future of Food"-Workshop we discover the joy of sustainable nutrition and how to avoid food waste. Together we will explore recipes with "wasted" food, exchange knowledge and learn about current projects and initiatives.

This workshop includes:

- **Insights:** into our food system and food waste in a fun and positive way
- **Exploring:** discover and try out amazing, creative recipes to avoid food waste
- **Learning:** get familiar with the sustainable nutritional concept of the Planetary Health Diet
- **Excursion:** to a sustainable nutrition project

Take-aways:

- Exchange and development of a plan to promote healthy and sustainable food in your company and the employees' personal lives


Combination of Workshop and Clean-Up

A **clean-up** combined with a **workshop** connects hands-on environmental action with sustainable learning. While jointly cleaning a section of shoreline, the impact of our actions becomes immediately tangible. In the workshops *The Future of Food* or *Circular Champions*, we deepen this experience through interactive, practical insights into sustainable consumption, waste reduction, and circular thinking. This creates concrete impulses that can be transferred into everyday life in the long term.

Here is an **example program** of a combined workshop and clean-up:

09:30 AM	Reception with tea/coffee
10:00 AM	Workshop <i>The Future of Food</i> or <i>Circular Champions</i>
12:00 PM	Lunch; if necessary, transfer to the clean-up location
13:30 PM	Reception at the clean-up site, introduction to the topic, guessing game
14:00 PM	Clean-Up
15:30 PM	Break with a small snack / input on plastics and consumption
16:00 PM	Continuation of the clean-up
17:00 PM	Joint weighing, sorting, and disposal of the collected waste
17:30 PM	Wrap-up and departure





Film Screening

The film *Our Planet: Our Business* raises an important question: How can the global economy contribute to addressing the worldwide environmental crisis?

Use *Our Planet: Our Business* to inspire colleagues and employees to engage in sustainability. A film screening within your organization creates a shared experience and provides powerful impulses. The film is available in different languages and lengths and can be flexibly adapted to your needs.

We recommend an event duration of 1 to 1.5 hours for the film screening followed by a Q&A session. These events can be held online, as in-person, or in a hybrid format.


